Tasting Notes

A fragrant Pinot Noir with juicy, ripe, red berry fruit and hint of spice. A supple, medium bodied wine perfect for any occasion.

Vineyards and viticulture

The grapes for this wine are from our Wairau Valley vineyard. The 2024 vintage gave us juicy, berry flavours in the grapes and these carried through to the finished wine.

Winemaking

Picked in the cool of the morning, the grapes were cold-soaked for several days then hand-plunged while fermenting in stainless-steel. We selected specific cultured yeasts to retain the aromatics and bright cherry characters
